NDCA Halloween Fun Friday

On Friday, October 30, 2020 the school will be having their Halloween Fun Friday Fundraising event. I would ask that everyone adhere to the following for the school day:

- **No Face Makeup – We are concerned that a child can have a reaction to the face makeup.**
- **No offensive costumes. Please do not wear a costume that can offend anyone.**
- **No political costumes. Please do not come into school dressed as a political candidate.**
- **No wigs – As you know the building can get warm, I would ask that a child not wear a wig to school, due to covid restrictions we are limited to how much we can help them if they get uncomfortable.**
- **Do: Dress up as your favorite celebrity or character**
 - Celebrities and characters are some of the best go-to costumes for Halloween. Celebrities are prominent in the media, so there's lots of photos of them to go off of, and obviously characters in film or television are easy to view and imitate. These costumes can give you a chance to spend the night portraying someone who you greatly admire or just think has a cool look.
- **Don't: Dress up like a celebrity or character you can't appropriately portray**
- **Do: Dress comfortably and warmly**
- **Don't: Wear uncomfortable and weather-inappropriate clothing**
- **The dress code in the handbook still stands.**
 - There may be occasions in which students are allowed to wear non-uniform attire. Students are reminded to dress with modesty. Students should adhere to the following attire:
 - Appropriate length skirt, shorts or dress – no shorter than 3" above the knees
 - No torn or tight jeans or pants
 - No spaghetti strap tanks, midriffs, tube tops, etc.
 - No logo type T-shirts
 - No hats (unless specifically designated)
 - No loose/baggy pants or shorts

- No make-up or nail polish (including gels/French manicures)
- No hoop earrings or excessive jewelry
- No jeggings, leggings or skinny jeans

- **Do: Dress up like action heroes or cool warrior figures**
- **Don't: Carry fake weapons or impersonate police officers or military personnel**

Parents – Your child's teacher has some great activities planned. I am not sure if a parade can happen, I will be monitoring the weather and see what we can figure out. We have put together the goody bags using gloves and in sanitary conditions, we have done our best to make sure that we separated nuts and no nut items. I would just ask that when your child gets home with their goody bag, that you please go through it prior to allowing your child to eat it JUST IN CASE we missed something.
