### *Third Grade Syllabus*

#### **English**

*Spelling and Vocabulary:* Spelling and vocabulary words will be handed out on Monday mornings. Every Friday there will be a quiz on words from the textbook listed above. Students will assigned spelling or vocabulary homework on Monday that will be due on Friday (day of quiz). This good review.

*Grammar:* Depending on the Unit, students will either be assigned a quiz or test. Prior to exam, students will be given a review in class as well as a review sheet to look over at home.

*Reading Comprehension:* Depending on the week and Unit, students will be given a quiz or test on the story that is read in class. Students may at any time bring home the textbook to review the story with parents/guardians before test.

In the middle of the year, as a class and individually we will be reading Charlotte's Web by E.B White. Books have been provided by the school. The exam will be broken down into chapters. There will also be a project (outlined details to follow as it approaches).

*Handwriting:* Students will be learning to write in script. This will be their "Do Now" when they arrive at school. Handwriting should always be done slow and neat! They will not be graded on the handwriting sheets given but will be counted towards participation. If handwriting is part of homework, it will be counted as a homework grade.

*Notebooks:* Notebooks are to be NEAT at all times. Notebooks will include visuals such as charts made and colored that will help students with spelling, vocabulary, grammar, and reading comprehension. This will also be a good review when it comes time for quizzes and test.

#### **Math**

We will be learning multiplication, division, fractions, solve time, capacity, and mass problems. As we begin learning multiplication with many methods, it's important for students to begin to familiarize themselves with the multiplication table outside of the classroom. Some suggestions are starting off with doing 1-4x on index cards OR have them write it out, depending on how your child retains information.

#### **Science**

Unit topics include learning science, engineering, and technology, life science, earth science, and physical science. Students will be given a test on the chapters. All students should review the textbook, notebook (notes), and review sheet given. Projects will be outlined in detail with plenty of time for completion.

### **Social Studies**

We will be using small booklets that contain different topics such as mapping our world, communities, geography, environment, resources, inventions and civilizations. Students will be given test on topics. All students should review the books, notebook (notes), and review sheet given. Projects will be outlined in detail with plenty of time for completion.

### **Religion**

We will be using the textbook. Students will be given test on the chapters. All students should review their notebook (notes) and review sheet given. Projects will be outlined in detail with plenty of time for completion.

### **IReady**

IReady will be used for math and reading in class . It offers an adaptive diagnostic, and both teacher made and individualized online instruction for a complete blended learning solution.

**All Homework:** Students will write homework in their notebook everyday as well as be posted on Google Classroom. Homework will be posted on the school website. There will be some nights where homework is a worksheet, workbook pages, or on Google Classroom. If there are any issues and you see your child struggling, please reach out to me ASAP. Homework will be gone over and checked everyday before we begin the subject. If a child is missing homework more than 3 times, I will be in contact with parents.

**All Quizzes/Tests:** Test and quizzes will be told one week prior. Review sheets will be handed out during the week of the exam. I am big with helping students out and giving them hints and tricks to remember certain words, methods, and ideas. All worksheets and notebooks should be neat and organized, as that is part of what they should studying from unless they're told. If you know your child is going to be absent on the day of a quiz or test and you want them to take it a day earlier, that is fine I would need to know as soon as possible. If your child is absent unexpectedly, please reach out to me so we could reschedule the quiz or test for the day the child returns to school. Due to circumstances we are facing today, I am very reasonable. Things happen and we will work together to make sure your child succeeds.

**Participation:** Students should always be participating, whether they understand the topic or not. That will help me help them! Participating will also boost a child's grade if they are struggling. It's understandable that some students may not be the best test takers. I need to see that they are trying their best.
